This donation helps us rescue more dogs and serve more veterans living with PTSD, traumatic brain injuries and other challenges - truly saving lives at both ends of the leash."

To recognize the work of La Russa and ARF helping pets across the country find their forever homes, Purina presented him with its *Better with Pets Award* during the National Dog Show Presented by Purina Gala on Nov. 16 in Philadelphia. The award was established four years ago to acknowledge people and organizations who have made a difference in strengthening the bond between pets and people. La Russa and ARF received this honor specifically for the ongoing support for shelter pets and helping them find forever homes in the service of veterans – all at no cost to the veteran.
